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Adolescent Clinics

Eau Claire, WI – October 3, 2017 – The Eau Claire City-County Health Department is providing free adolescent vaccinations – including flu – at seven middle schools in Eau Claire County: Northstar, DeLong, South, Altoona, Fall Creek, Augusta and Regis. Students will be able to get a flu shot and any of the following adolescent immunizations at no cost: Tdap and Meningococcal. Adults can receive flu shots for \$43. Students from any school in Eau Claire County and their families are welcome to attend any one of the clinics.

“By partnering with the school districts, we are able to offer an opportunity for adolescents to be up-to-date on their immunizations in a convenient and accessible environment for them and their families,” explains Patricia Reis, Public Health Nurse. The clinics are offered during part of the school day as well as after school hours, if parents prefer to be there with their children, or want immunizations themselves. One of the school superintendents, Mary Ann Hardebeck of the Eau Claire Area School District, states “Tending to the well-being of our students is one of our most important responsibilities. We are pleased to be in partnership with the Health Department in helping families to keep their children healthy and safe.”
