SECTION 5 - Boards, Commissions and Committees

Over 150 citizens serve the City on boards, commissions and committees. These groups may advise the City Council in various subject areas and may even make independent decisions, depending on the governmental body.

The City Manager's Office maintains a Citizen Resource Bank made up of city residents interested in serving on boards, commissions or committees. The primary qualifications are an interest in participating in City government and a willingness to work with others to help address the needs of the community.

The Committee Code of Conduct, to which representatives serving on boards, commissions and committees are held, is also included for reference.
