



## **City of Eau Claire Public Comment Period**

The City Council and City staff members want to maintain open communication with the people who live and work in Eau Claire. If you have specific questions, opinions, ideas, or concerns regarding the City, do not hesitate to directly contact your Council Representative by their phone or e-mail or contact the City Manager at 715-839-4902.

Residents of Eau Claire or individuals who own a business or property in Eau Claire are also welcome to take part in a Public Comment Period which follows the regularly scheduled Monday Public Hearing meeting of the Eau Claire City Council.

Here's a quick run-down of how the Public Comment Period Works:

The comment period follows the regularly scheduled Monday City Council meeting and lasts for up to a total of 20 minutes.

Each individual speaker is allowed a total of three minutes and may not speak more than once during any given session.

The Public Comment Period is for new ideas, concerns or comments of residents that that could be acted upon by the City Council.

Comments shall not be on items listed on the evening's agenda. The time to comment on those items is during the meeting. The Council President will indicate when members of the public can comment.

The Council will not hear personal complaints about City personnel, elected public officials or any person affiliated with the City or any personal matter including claims, citations, appeals, or lawsuits.

Profane, disruptive, or threatening speech or conduct is unacceptable and will not be tolerated.

Those wishing to comment during the Public Comment Period may sign up prior to the session but it's not required.
