

ORDINANCE NO. 7359

ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 10.20 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF EAU CLAIRE ENTITLED “PARKING METERS AND LOTS.”

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EAU CLAIRE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That section 10.20.080 entitled “Meters – Parking lots, ramps and streets” and specifically paragraph G. is hereby deleted:

G. Meters shall be installed in the parking area located at the lower level of the L.E. Phillips Memorial Library, which shall be enforceable during the hours that the library is open to the public. Such meters shall be two-hour meters, and the parking fee shall be as stated in the City of Eau Claire Fees and License Schedule. No person shall permit a vehicle to remain in the metered stall for a period longer than two hours.

SECTION 2. That section 10.20.080 entitled “Meters – Parking lots, ramps and streets” and specifically paragraph A. is hereby amended as follows:

A. The parking lots owned or leased by the city are ~~established~~ both metered and unmetered parking meter zones and the same, and for enforcement purposes, are placed under the jurisdiction of the police department or the police department’s designee.

SECTION 3. That section 10.20.100 entitled “Unmetered parking lots and parking ramps” is hereby amended as follows:

10.20.100 Unmetered parking lots and parking ramps. The following unmetered parking lots and parking ramps are established with parking hours, rates and times as stated in the City of Eau Claire Fees and Licenses Schedule: Barstow Street Lot, Chippewa Street Lot, Forest Street Lot, Municipal Parking Ramp, Riverside Parking Deck, Riverview Parking Lot, Schlegelmilch-McDaniel Lot, Seaver Street Lot ~~and~~ Starr Avenue/Birch Street Lot, and L.E. Phillips Memorial Public Library.

SECTION 4. The City of Eau Claire Fees and Licenses Schedule is hereby revised to remove fees for Library Lot Parking. Amendments to this change may be made by City Council resolution.
