**Dog Bite: Health Department Needs Your Help Finding a Dog**

**Eau Claire, January 9, 2024** – The Eau Claire City-County Health Department is asking for your help to find a dog that bit a man on Monday, January 8 at approximately 10:15-10:30 a.m.

The bite occurred at the intersection of Park Avenue and Park Place in Eau Claire. At the time, the dog was being walked alongside another dog by a blonde-haired woman wearing a dark-colored winter jacket.

The dog was described as a small to medium-size black dog.

We need to find this dog to determine its health and rabies status. If we don't find this dog, it could bite again, and the bite victim may need to have a series of expensive injections to prevent rabies.
