<b>COMMON HOMEOWNER TESTS</b>	
<b>Bacteria (Coliform + E. coli)</b> Tests for presence of bacteria. Recommended annually.	\$27
<b>Bacteria - Quantitative/TECTA</b> This test is typically used for produce growers and urgent city water requirements. <i>(Needs to be scheduled in advance with lab)</i>	\$37
<b>Nitrate</b> Pregnant women and infants are most at risk, may indicate presence of other contaminants. Recommended annually.	\$27
<b>Total Hardness</b> Important factor in water softening. May have scaly residues and difficulty lathering.	\$32
<b>pH</b> Measures water acidity to help assess corrosivity of water to lead and copper pipes.	\$15
<b>Fluoride</b> Naturally occurring in groundwater, useful for considering fluoride supplements for young children.	\$27
<b>Lead</b> May leach from lead-containing solder and fixtures due to corrosive water. Especially harmful to pregnant women, infants, and young children.	\$32
<b>Copper</b> May leach from pipes due to corrosive water. Water may taste metallic and leave blue-green stains in sinks.	\$32
<b>Arsenic</b> Has no taste or odor. Can be toxic even at low levels. Wells should be tested for arsenic at least once before use.	\$32
<b>Manganese</b> Water may have black specks, metallic taste, or cause stained plumbing fixtures or laundry. Toxic at high levels.	\$32

## ADDITIONAL TESTS AVAILABLE

<p><b>Nitrite</b> Uncommon in groundwater but required for some home loans.</p>	\$34
<p><b>Iron Bacteria</b> Not known to harm health but are a nuisance. Water may smell musty, swampy, or oily. May appear yellow, orange, or red and leave stains. May also have a rainbow colored, oil-like sheen and red slimy deposits.</p>	\$40
<p><b>Sulfate Reducing Bacteria</b> Not known to harm health but are a nuisance. Water may have rotten egg smell, black and yellow staining on silverware, corrosion on pipes and metal components, and slime deposits.</p>	\$40
<p><b>Iron</b> Water may have a metallic taste or leave brown or orange stains.</p>	\$32
<p><b>Homeowner's Bundle</b> <i>(Bacteria, Nitrate, Arsenic, Copper, Manganese, Lead)</i></p>	\$100
<p><b>Homeowner's PLUS Bundle</b> <i>(Homeowner's Bundle + Iron and Hardness)</i></p>	\$120
