Dog Bite: Health Department Needs Your Help Finding a Dog

Eau Claire, WI, December 5, 2024 – The Eau Claire City-County Health Department is asking for your help to find a dog that bit a teenage girl on Tuesday, December 3 at 3 p.m. The bite happened on W. Moholt Drive in Eau Claire.

The person walking the dog was described as an older woman wearing a jacket and hat. The dog was described as a medium-sized black dog with short hair, possible a Labrador retriever-type breed.

We need to find this dog to determine its health and rabies status. If we don't find this dog it could bite again, and the bite victim may need to have a series of expensive injections to prevent rabies.
