PROJECT OVERVIEW

Current Date: June 4, 2025

Construction on:

- Seymour Road, from Zephyr Hill Avenue to Brookline Avenue.
- Malden Avenue, from Gala Street to Seymour Road.
- Brookline Avenue, from Seymour Road to Deerfield Drive.

Tentative start date: Concrete repairs are scheduled to begin Wednesday, June 11, with milling of the asphalt surface scheduled for Friday, June 19. Work will take place on Seymour Road and Malden Avenue initially, with Brookline Drive work scheduled to begin the week of June 16.

Proposed Work: The City will be improving the surface of the above streets as part of a maintenance project. Work will include concrete curb and gutter repairs, pedestrian ramp replacement, milling asphalt pavement, new asphalt surface, pavement markings, and restoration of disturbed areas.

The contractor for this project will have various sub-contractors working for them throughout project completion.

ACCESS

Seymour Road, Malden Avenue, and Brookline Avenue will remain open to traffic during construction, with possible lane restrictions or one-way traffic. Please be aware that Brookline Drive north of Clearwater Ridge Drive will be closed to traffic under a different project, beginning June 10, 2025.

There may be times when construction equipment and activities delay access to the street or your property. Please be patient and drive carefully during this work.
