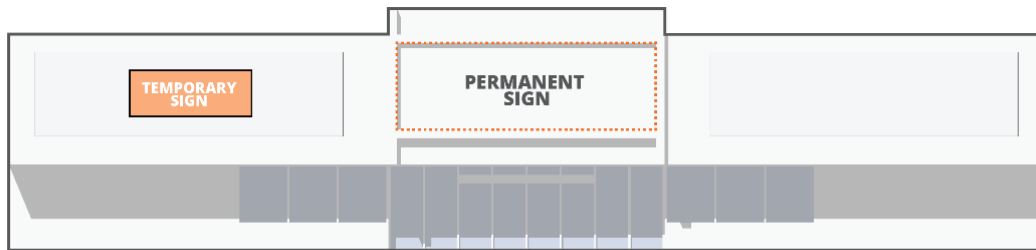

[1] Exception to sign quantity is allowed beginning, whichever comes first, (i) 90 days before the day of an election for office or referendum or (ii) on the first day for circulation of nomination papers by candidates or the day on which the referendum question is submitted to the electorate, and ending 30 days after the election for office or referendum.					
[2] For non-residential districts may be increased up to 32 square feet in area.
