Upon a motion duly made and carried, the City Council may go into closed session to review and discuss candidates for appointment to the position of interim City Manager, which is permitted in closed session pursuant to s. 19.85(1)(c) of the Wisconsin Statutes

Please take further notice that a public regular meeting of the City Council will be held at 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, May 12, 2026, in the Council Chamber of City Hall, 203 South Farwell Street, Eau Claire, Wisconsin. Upon a motion duly made and carried, the City Council may go into closed session to discuss and receive negotiation direction on the acquisition of land adjacent to I-94. City staff are seeking negotiation direction from Council regarding the potential purchase of land. This item involves the deliberating and negotiating the potential purchase of public properties and use of public funds, which is authorized for closed session pursuant to Wis. Stats. Section 19.85(1)(e).

Following the Legislative session, the Council will convene in the Council Chamber for two work sessions on the following items:

1. The City Council will hold a work session on the 2027-2031 Capital Improvement Plan.
2. The City Council will hold a work session to discuss the process for hiring a new City Manager.

The City Council may provide direction to City staff regarding the hiring process.
